Sub: Grant of conditional permission to the **Prem Raghu Ayurvedic Medical College, Agra Road, Distt. – Hathras, Uttar Pradesh, with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course** under Section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 for the academic session 2018-19– reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the Ministry's order No. R. F.No.R-12011/27/2015- EP(IM-I) for 2017-18 dated 05.08.2017 related to admission matter for the year 2017-18 intimating certain shortcomings for rectification for consideration of the case for the academic session 2018-19.

2. The CCIM had carried out an inspection of the institution on 05.02.2018 and re-visited on 25-26.05.2018 to reassess the available facilities of teaching and practical training as well as to verify the compliance submitted by the college and forwarded its recommendations and report to the Ministry examining the same, it was observed that- Higher faculty in the departments of Rog Nidan, Swasthavritha & Yoga and Prasuti & Striroga, Computerized Central Registration system & Web based Computerized Central Registration system, required Instrument in the departments of Dissection Hall, Pharmacognosy laboratory, Casualty & Labour Room, Demo room in Herbal Garden, Quality Testing Laboratory, functional Operation Theatre, functional of X-Ray, ECG and USG, and functional Aadhaar based Geo location enabled attendance system for teaching staff, non-teaching staff, hospital staff were not available. Therefore, under provisions of the first proviso to sub-section (5) of Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, an opportunity of hearing was granted to the college to present the case on 18.08.2018 and 17.10.2018 vide Ministry's letter dated 09.08.2018 and 12.10.2018.

3. The observation of hearing Committee based on submission made by the college representative during hearing and recommendations & visitation report of the CCIM have been carefully examined in terms of Regulation 3 and 10 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made thereunder, and as per approved Standard Operative Procedures (SOPs) for the UG course for grant of conditional permission for the academic session 2018-19 and it has been decided by the Central Government for *grant of conditional permission to Prem Raghu Ayurvedic Medical College, Agra Road, Distt. - Hathras, Uttar Pradesh*, to take admissions for 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2018-19 under section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, subject to the condition that the college shall fulfill the following requirements by 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2018:

- (i) Aadhaar based Geo location enabled attendance system for teaching staff, non-teaching staff, hospital staff as per RMS, 2016.
- (ii) Functional X-Ray, ECG and USG section in the Hospital.
- (iii) Verification of Functional Operation Theatre on basis of OT stock register, record of surgical cases, attendance of OT staff, OT Anaesthesia/consent records, OT investigations & discharge records etc.
- (iv) Verification of the availability of Equipments & Instruments in the Dissection Hall, Pharmacognosy laboratory, Casualty & Labour Room, on the basis of stock registers and purchase bills.
- (v) Verification of the availability of Equipments & Instruments in the Quality Testing Laboratory on the basis of stock register and purchase bills and pharmacy & Laboratory staff on the basis of on the basis of Appointment & Joining Letter, Salary Record, Bank Salary details and Attendance register.
- (vi) 25-50 Sq. Mtr. Demo room in Herbal Garden.

4. In addition, following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2018 to get conditional permission for the session 2019-20:

- (i) all the Requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
- (ii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda); and
- (iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*.
